
Hi All - HAPPY SPRING! It is coming/it is here - depending on where you are $\stackrel{\bullet}{\smile}$

Business and Marketing Honor Society (BMHS) see our website **HERE**

BMHS Purpose

The primary purpose of the Business and Marketing Honor Society of New York State is to recognize students who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in business education at the secondary level.

BMHS Eligibility

- * Students must be currently enrolled in at least one business education (fall and/or spring) course
- * Seniors: Must complete 3 units in Business Education by the end of the current school year
- * Sophomores/Juniors: Must complete 2 units in Business Education by the end of the current school year and should be planning to enroll in at least one additional unit prior to graduation.

BMHS Criteria

MINIMUM CRITERIA

In Business Education courses: Minimum of 88 percent or B+ or 3.5 GPA

Overall: 80 percent or B or 3.0 GPA

ADDITIONAL CRITERIA MIGHT INCLUDE

Students demonstrating exemplary Character, Leadership, and Service in the classroom as well as in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities

APPLICATION PROCESS

The process might be initiated by the Student with an application OR by the Business Education Department with an application or recommendation process. Business and Marketing Honor Society members might be required to provide service to the community, co-curricular, or extra-curricular activities to maintain membership in the Business and Marketing Honor Society of New York State.

PROCEDURES

- * School's Business Education Department verifies eligibility and selects students.
- * School requests Business and Marketing Honor Society of New York State certificates, pins, membership cards and/or seals from BTANYS using the Order Form (under revision, will be updated/active by 09/01/21)
- * School's Business Education Department completes certificates and membership cards.
- * School's Business Education Department is encouraged to hold a Business and Marketing Honor Society Induction independent of or in conjunction with other student honor societies.
- * School's Business Education Department may also wish to prepare a congratulatory letter to each student. A copy might be provided to the student's school counselor for inclusion in student's permanent file. Click here to view a sample Congratulatory Letter.

All nominees MUST be current BTANYS members for 21-22 school year.

Per BTANYS By-Laws: Each regional director and special director shall assume duties on July 1 for a term of three (3) years until his or her successor is elected and qualified except as outlined in Section 13. Each directorship shall be limited to two (2) elected terms.

Section 10: A regional or special director nominee shall be a BTANYS member. A regional director nominee shall reside and/or work in the region to be represented and be certified and/or employed in business education. Upon retirement, a regional director shall retire from their BTANYS position as of June 30.

Section 11: Any director presently on the executive board who runs for a position of an officer shall automatically resign the directorship effective June 30 of that year.

Section 12: In addition to representing a region, the regional director shall be given a functional responsibility by the president. It shall be the responsibility of the director to either perform that function or to delegate the functional responsibility to a qualified BTANYS member.

Section 13: All directors shall be elected by the members for a three (3) year term or until his or her successor is elected and qualified:
