Updates from NYSED Business Liaison Michael LaMastra

- The Board of Regents have waived technical assessments for students in NYSED-approved programs for this
 school year. Please see the <u>press release from our department</u> and the <u>corresponding board item</u> (page 33) for
 full details.
- The Board has also waived for this school year any requirements for the CDOS credential that were unable to be met due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Please refer to the press release linked above and the linked board item (page 35) for full details. To exit students with the credential (which may be used as a +1 for the 4+1 CDOS pathway to a Regents Diploma), the district must otherwise determine that the student has otherwise demonstrated knowledge and skills relating to the commencement level career development occupational studies learning standards.
- There is a great summer opportunity for rising seniors in the Southern Tier (read web link for exact counties) in the area of entrepreneurship. The Appalachian Entrepreneurship Academy will be accepting a new cohort of students this summer. The deadline to sign up is April 2. More information can be found here.
- Mercy College is also running a summer business program for students. More information can be found here.

Coalition Announcement sharing also:

As you have probably heard, all August 2021 Regents exams are cancelled. All but <u>four</u> June 2021 Regents exams are also cancelled for now and the New York State Education Department (NYSED) is still hoping for Federal approval to cancel ALL June 2021 Regents. On Monday, the Board of Regents also approved exemptions to graduation requirements for students planning to take any Regents exam in 2021.

- Attached are is a memo and FAO from NYSED out today with more information about the exemptions.

In short, the new emergency regulations mean that regardless of whether they sit for exams offered in June, many young people are eligible for COVID-19 exemptions to graduation requirements. This means students can graduate this year or in future years without the Regents exam in that subject area if ANY of the following applies:

- 1. They are taking a Regents course <u>this school year</u> and earn all of the credits in the sequence by the end of summer school 2021; OR
- 2. During <u>any previous school year</u>, they finished a Regents course sequence AND notify their current/previous school that they intend to take the corresponding June 2021 or August 2021 exam and want the exemption; OR
- 3. Are a 7th or 8th grader and pass a Regents course sequence in 2019-20 or 2020-21.
